Award Set-up Process

- Awards are setup in WISPER and projects are activated in GRANTS. We do not use WISPER routing as WARF funding is and award- not a proposal.
- Awards are typically set up on the fiscal year, July 1-June 30, but some of the non-Fall Competition strategic funding initiatives are run on a non-fiscal year.
- When an award is made the recipient and department administrator are notified.
- Awards must adhere to UW-Madison policies (https://policy.wisc.edu/).
- Divisions, School or Colleges may have stricter policies.



Flexible vs Detailed Budgets

Flexible

- Lump sump budget
- Must cover all expenses including associated fringe and tuition expenses.
- Balance to zero at the end.

Detailed Budget

- Must keep spending within budget lines
- OVCRGE covers differences when annual rates change.

Unallowable Costs

- Awards can be made with restrictions. Any restrictions specific to the award will be within award letter.
- If an award is made for a specific purpose, the expenses should be related.
- Items generally viewed as departmental responsibilities
 - Phones and phone line charges
 - Office Furnishings
 - Computers
 - General office supplies
- Program code 9 is only allowable on Grad School funding support, not on OVCRGE support.



Re-budget and Extension Requests

- Awards can be both extended and re-budgeted when necessary
 - Requests made by using the Change Request Form: <u>https://research.wisc.edu/change-request-for-vcrge-funds-2/</u>
 - Must provide explanation of necessity along with revised budget for review to VCRGE Accounting
 - May require Associate Vice Chancellor approval
 - Tuition remission and fringe allocations CANNOT be re-budgeted.
 - Requests should be made in advance of the end date of the award.



Award Closeout

- Awards are monitored on a monthly basis.
 - Expiring End Dates
 - Overspending
 - Zero-balance
- Prior to closing an award expenses are reviewed and any anomalies are addressed with the department.



Year-End Award Closeout

- If awards are within \$100 of zero they can be closed out without follow-up by VCRGE.
- If there is a balance in the project, but VCRGE Accounting does not receive an extension request, the project will be closed.
- Department should update payroll/encumbrances to new funding at this time.



Award close out examples exercise

These projects are ready to be closed out. What needs to happen before the project can be closed. There may be unanswered questions that you would need to follow up on with the PI's department.
